Math: We continue to review skip counting (by 2s & 5s). We are working with patterns and looking at the patterns in numbers – (also the patterns we see when skip counting). We are working at using subitizing to learn addition facts.

Language Arts: Work continues on assessing where students are regarding Phonemic Awareness, Phonics, and Reading, as well as filling in background knowledge necessary for understanding the first story in our Open Court reader. Spelling

consists mostly of words which can be phonetically decoded and therefore also spelled phonetically, though occasionally, there may be part of a word that is considered a "heart" word. (See if your child can tell you what that means!) Students have been working at learning how to properly do each assignment in their first unit. After a few units, as they become familiar with the procedures, they will know how to do assignments in all the units.

PE: We have PE first thing on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. Students should be prepared with the proper clothing to participate in all activities

(*Monday*): Church History: We worship a holy God! Math: Attributes of 3D solids - faces, edges, vertices

Grammar: Types of sentences: statements begin with a capital
