A geometry test is scheduled for Monday. Review: Venn diagrams, polygon names (quadrilateral, pentagon, hexagon, heptagon, octagon), vertices, angles (acute, right, obtuse), parallel lines, congruency, & distinctives between square, rhombus, and rectangle. On Tuesday Dec 12 we'll begin learning how to play Chess during Math over nine classes. Why? a) Students work with rows and columns b) Chess assists brain development (exercises both sides of the brain), grows dendrites, improves concentration, increases creativity, improves memory, increases problem-solving skills, teaches planning and foresight (no prior knowledge of Chess is expected.)
